

WYCHAVON PARISH GAMES

CROSS COUNTRY

1. Competitors must reside in the Parish they represent.
2. The event shall be conducted under AAA Laws and Rules.
3. The competition will be held on Monday 7th September 2009 at Pershore High School, Station Road, Pershore, starting at 6.30 pm. Teams should be ready 15 minutes before the start time.
4. The entire distance will not exceed 8000 metres.
5. Parishes will be entitled to enter a team of 6 runners of any age, but all runners **MUST** be 14 or over on the day of the event. To avoid any embarrassment, it may be worth bringing proof of age with you if there is likely to be any doubt.
6. Parishes do not need to enter a full team, but a minimum of 2 runners must take part. Teams with 6 runners will take the first places, followed by teams with five, four, etc.
7. Teams shall be under the management and control of the Parish Organisers, who shall appoint a team captain for the event.
8. Failure to comply with the above rules may mean the Parish being disqualified.
9. All selected runners shall be declared in writing at least 30 minutes before the start of the race.
10. There will only be one race for this competition.
11. Official judges shall decide the respective places of the scoring competitors of each Parish and add these together. The Parish having the lowest aggregate shall be declared the winning Parish. In the event of a tie, the Parish whose last scoring player competitor finishes nearest the first place shall determine the result.
12. Any protest must be made to the Competition Organiser by the Parish Captain as soon as possible and not later than the close of the event. The decision by the Competition Organiser shall be final.
13. The course will be marked with guides and flags. There will be a clear run of 200 metres at the finish.
14. Toilet and changing facilities will be available at the School.
