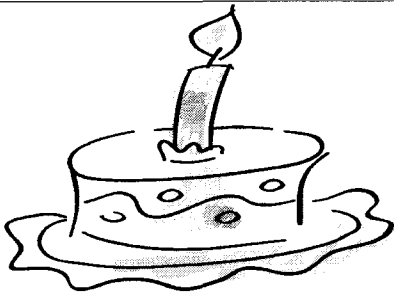
This is a fundraiser to help homeless pets at the shelter. Cost is \$50 per person which can be paid by cash, check or credit card by calling 867-5727.
