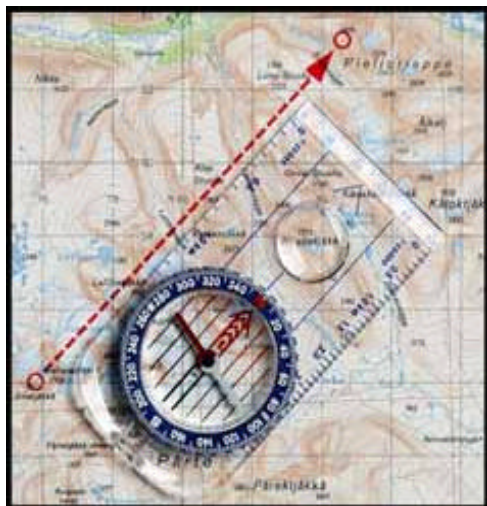

POPCORN SALES ARE COMING!

The annual Boy Scout popcorn fundraiser is coming. Scouts will have four weeks to sell popcorn (from September 26 through October 23). While sales can't begin until September 26, Scouts should let their last year's customers and family members know about the upcoming popcorn sale. Mr. Peter Udall (598-0620) is leading the popcorn sales.

DONUTS

Troop 120 sells donuts at Fellowship Bible Church on each Sunday. The troop raises money and Scouts can earn money to put towards their accounts. Volunteers are needed - contact Mrs. Lamb.

UNIFORMS

Scouts are to wear their Class A uniforms (official Boy Scout tan shirt and Boy Scout green pants or shorts) to the Court of Honor and Eagle Ceremonies. Scouts may wear blue jeans or blue jean shorts with their "Class A" tan shirts to regular Troop meetings. If you need a uniform or patches and badges sewn in place, bring them to the troop uniform closet at 8:15 p.m. A nominal \$1 charge per patch will be deducted from your account.

Your troop account will be charged \$10 if a Scout needs a tan shirt or green pants and \$5 for shorts. A new patrol patch is \$1.86. There is no charge for any patches, which are awarded (Tenderfoot, Quality Unit, Patrol Leader). Scouts may retain their rank and leadership patches for a scrapbook or shadow box.

Troop T-shirts (\$7) are worn for summer camp, campouts and service projects. Our troop usually travels to and from outings in the tan Class A shirt and blue jeans or blue jean shorts.

All tan shirts in our troop closet will have "120" numerals and a Pikes Peak Council patch. If you need shoulder loops, more numerals or a world crest patch, they are available from our uniform closet or Hibbard Scout Shop on Uintah for a nominal charge. You will receive a "credit" for uniforms turned back to the closet when Scouts need a larger size.
