PROJECTS

Traffic and Road Safety



A well lighted and painted guard outpost was installed at Phase 2 along the main road of FCIE. This is to ensure the availability of security personnel in areas far from the Security Office especially at night to respond to emergency cases.

Traffic cones were also placed in strategic locations inside FCIE to avoid vehicular accidents.

The main road concrete curbs and pedestrian lanes were repainted to preserve the road visibility especially at night.

Visible roving security personnel are assigned 24 hours daily, to monitor the estate, apprehend traffic violators, and assist motorists inside FCIE.

In order to minimize occurrence of road accidents, all motorists are required to observe speed limits upon entry in FCIE. Violators shall be immediately apprehended and penalize.

Visible signages in front of main gate are installed to continuously remind all motorist to maintain normal speed while driving inside the estate.

Energy Savings

Due to continuous power rates hike, the FCIE acquired and utilizes Variable Speed Drive (VSD) for the FCIE deepwells. With 6 VSDs, FCIE realizes a total of 12.72% savings or a total of P1.5 Million per year.

The installation of VSD also improved the energy efficiency of FCIE deepwells and realized 12.72% kWr or an estimated savings of P 1.5 million pesos yearly.



Reinforced Fence



The old and dilapidated fence in FCIE located at the back of FCIE Meralco substation and former SCA Hygiene Product has been restored using welded wires. Other existing concrete fence at the back of Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) at Phase 3 was also reinforced with welded wires to strictly secure the area.

Ecological Solid Waste Management

It's always been FCIE's goal to keep a clean and pollution free environment. The solid wastes collected at the green areas, administration complex, and public places of FCIE are properly segregated and temporarily stored in a garbage bin, regular hauling is done by a private hauler for proper waste disposal.
