REVISED  
RULES AND REGULATIONS

**ALL VENDORS:**

- 1) Vendors may not sell any type of or have stored in the vendor area any of the following. Vendors with these items will be asked to leave and will not receive a refund:
  - a) Fireworks, including but not limited to “Snappers”, Crackerballs”, “Poppers”, or any other device that explodes on impact. No Smoke Bombs, Sparklers or any type of device that has to be ignited. **Any device generally considered to be a “Fireworks” is not allowed.**
  - b) Aerosol or compressed air products, including but not limited to “Spray String”, “Silly String”, Hair Colorant, Hair Sprays, Paint or any item considered to be such.
  - c) Any item or device that produces a waste product
  - d) **Any item considered to be a weapon**, such as knives, guns, swords, throwing stars, mace or self defense sprays are not allowed.
- 2) All Vendors must clean up the area around their booth space before they leave at the end of the day. The space must be left as it was found, **CLEAN.**
- 3) The Festival Committee reserves the right to remove any vendor from the festival if it feels the Vendor is in violation of the rules or spirit of the Festival. **BOOTH FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED IF THE VENDOR IS CONSIDERED TO BE IN VIOLATION OF THE RULES.**
- 4) Do not exceed the space that you have rented even if it is empty. The spaces are 10’ x 10’. You may rent as many spaces as you will need to display your wares.
- 5) All Vendors must keep the area around their space clean and free of trash.
- 6) There will be absolutely no animals of any kind permitted in the festival area by ordinance of the Town of Swansboro. If you are accompanied by an animal, you will not be allowed to set up and you will not be given a refund.
- 7) **APPLICATION CONFIRMATION** If you provide a self addressed, stamped envelope when you return your application, the committee will mail it to you. Otherwise, we will email you a confirmation with the email address you provide on your application.
- 8) **Refunds will NOT be given for bad weather. Except in the most extreme case, the festival WILL proceed. Final decision will be made by festival committee.**
- 9) Craft vendors are those classified as selling items personally made by the vendor, NOT commercially produced. These vendors also may include home businesses, such as Mary Kay, Tupperware, etc. Commercial vendors are those selling commercially produced retail items

**FOOD VENDORS:**

- 1) Selling of any food or beverage that can be consumed during the festival, (intended or not) constitutes a “Food Vendor” and is subject to the fees set forth on the application for food vendors. This includes, but is not limited to: candy, popcorn, cakes, produce, peanuts, gum, lemonade, soups, soft drinks, sno-cones, packaged foods. If you can drink it or eat it, it’s a food or beverage.
- 2) Food Vendors must have a permit from the Onslow County Health Department. Permits may be obtained from:

- 3) Do not pour oil, grease, dirty water or other waste on the ground or into the trash cans. You must take it with you.
- 4) You may sell only the food and drink listed on your application and approved by the committee. We will limit the number of vendors selling major items. This is to protect you and other vendors by eliminating duplication of food and drinks..
- 5) Glass containers or bottles may not be sold to the public.
- 6) The Festival Committee does not provide ice to vendors.
- 7) **BEER AND OTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY NOT BE SOLD FOR CONSUMPTION AT THE FESTIVAL.**
- 8) Food vendors may not set up on dirt or grass unless they are in a self-contained truck or trailer. (per the Onslow County Health Department)
- 9) Bring your own products. The festival committee will no longer sell these items.

**NOTICE: CHECK-IN TIMES WILL BE ASSIGNED ACCORDING TO YOUR BOOTH SPACE. SWANSBORO IS A SMALL TOWN WITH NARROW STREETS. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT YOU CHECK IN AT YOUR DESIGNATED TIME.**
