

Liability policy

Flight horizons does not accept liability for any harm or damage to property that you may receive as an employee, volunteer or guest with them. Unless the harm or damage is due to negligence – in which case it is the individual or group of individuals who have been negligent that have responsibility.

No employee or volunteer has liability for any harm or damage to property that you may receive as an employee, volunteer or guest with Flight horizons.

No person may fly with Flight horizons without signing the required liability exemption forms.

Any person flying in an aircraft owned, leased or otherwise used by Flight horizons accepts full responsibility for their health and possession. Flight horizons makes every effort to ensure the environment is safe for its service users but in the unlikely event of an accident you accept full liability for any harm done to yourself and the people over which you have consent responsibility and yours and their possessions.

Neither Flight horizons nor it's employees or volunteers have any liability for any accident or damage that occurs on the way to, from or at the location of the Flight horizons flight or as a result of the booking of a Flight horizons flight.
