

### When to fly policy

Unfortunately due to external factors from time to time Flight horizons may not be able to have flights. In this case the guests should be informed as soon as practical and in advance if there is a probability that they will not fly.

Flight horizons Pilot's must obey the law and as such must comply with the CAA and European weather minimum as applicable. Proper planning must be done to ensure that all parties concerned receive information about a cancelled flight as soon as possible. It is the individual pilot's responsibility to decide whether or not conditions are suitable for flight.

Occasionally it may be necessary for a whole day to be cancelled this can only be done with the consultation of the chairman of the governing committee.
