Minutes for May 21, 2009

President Teajuana Mahone opened the meeting at 7 PM.

Vickie Unger introduced our speaker, Delores Keaton, of Thimble & Thread Quilt Guild. In her early years, Delores was inspired by her mother who made satin stitch embroidered flowers and decorated square dance skirts with them, also framing them and giving them as gifts. Delores tried lots of crafts and then started her quilting career by making a quilted coat, paper-pieced vest, a Jacket Jazz jacket and then decided she needed a new sewing machine. Her first quilt was paper-pieced and hand quilted. She finished a bubblegum pink 40's quilt that was in the family. Signed up at Quilted Fox to make a paper-pieced block-of-the-month for a year. Became interested in Toby Lischko's miniature quilts and made some of her own. By this time, she wanted to do her own thing, and entered a piece in the U. City juried quilt show and took 1st in innovative design. Later in another U. City show, she took second place to Suzanne Marshall.

Her bargello quilt was voted viewer's choice at a Thimble & Thread quilt show and soon she had a pattern in the book Star Quilts. While Delores was honing her skills, Toby was making quilt patterns for magazines. They started working together with Delores making the tops and Toby quilting them. They have made 35 tops so far for patterns and magazines, with Blue Bayou on the cover of Quilter's World. The last Thimble & Thread raffle quilt was designed by Delores from a Piece 'O Cake pattern. She brought many quilts to show us and ended her program by recounting the story of one special quilt, Crown of Feathers.
