

WHAT IS CULTURAL PLANNING?

Cultural planning is a strategic process which illuminates and gives significance to the values, and the material and process dimensions of culture in a way that informs Council's thinking, policies and programs.

A Cultural Plan consists of

1. A local cultural 'framework' about what is important to residents of the Shire
2. An action plan/cultural strategy based on community consultation
3. A budget
