



CUB SCOUT PACK 20

CAMPING TRIP — SEPTEMBER 18 & 19, 2004

Where: Camp River Trails in Sheridan, Illinois. You have the choice to sleep in the lodges (boys in “Merrybrook” and girls in “Dream Catcher”) or sleep in a tent. Cub Scouts are only permitted to sleep with other Cub Scouts or their own parents in the tents. A Scout cannot have another adult in the tent that is not their own parent. If Scouts sleep in the lodge or cabins, they must have a parent with them. The kids sleep on the floor. There are a few cots and/or mattresses in each lodge, which are for adult use. The lodges have electricity and are equipped with kitchens, showers and indoor bathrooms.

When: September 18, 2004 at noon to September 19, 2004 at noon.

Who: Cub Scouts, parent(s), sibling(s), but no pets. Each scout must have at least one parent along on the trip.

Meals: Will be provided, to be prepared together as a group.

Cost: \$15.00 per person (maximum of \$50.00 per family), plus late fee payable to “Cub Scout Pack 20”.
(This covers part of the cost...the difference is paid by Pack funds.)
