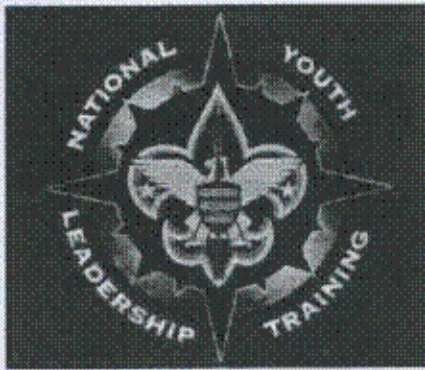

Dear Unit Leader:

The Anthony Wayne Area Council, BSA has established a tradition of quality training for youth leaders. The summer of 2006 will be no exception! The Anthony Wayne Area Council is pleased to announce the new national approach to training youth leaders. For the summer of 2007, Anthony Wayne Area Council will be introducing the new "National Youth Leadership Training" (NYLT) program to train youth leaders. We at the Council are very excited about the new direction National is moving.

The new NYLT course will incorporate team building concepts, using appropriate leadership styles, patrol method and Outdoor skills to create situations that reinforce the leadership training concepts acquired during the week. By the end of the conference each participant will create his own "Personal Conference Goals/Vision," which is a contract written by the scout to share with his unit leader. This contract outlines how the youth leader, under his unit leader's guidance, will utilize the skills, knowledge, and experience learned at NYLT in the execution of his unit leadership position.

Upon finishing the six day course, and completion of his "Personal Conference Goals" that were established during the conference, each Scout is National Youth Leader Trained. Conference staff members help participants define and set their personal goals. Please remember that these "Personal Conference Goals" are flexible and can be amended to meet changing situations in the Scout's home unit. When a Scout's "Personal Conference Goals" are completed to the satisfaction of the Scout and his unit leader, the unit leader sends a letter of completion to the NYLT Conference Staff. With prior arrangements, a NYLT Staff member may present the certificate and patch.

The NYLT course is ideal for training Senior Patrol Leaders and Patrol Leaders. It can also be a valuable experience for older boys. In order to attend any NYLT course, A Scout must have the following qualifications by the beginning of the course:

- *Should be in a leadership position or be identified to be a leader in his unit following completion of the NYLT Course.
- *Must Be a First Class Scout
- *Be 13 years of age and have completed the seventh grade before June 10, 2007.
- *One-year tenure in the Boy Scouts of America.
- *Attend at least one long-term (6 nights) camping experience before June 10, 2007.
- *A desire to participate in an intensive training experience and upon completion applies his leadership skills in service to the Scouts in his unit.

Experience has shown that Scouts younger than 13 often lack the physical and emotional maturity to benefit fully from the NYLT experience. Those who have not earned the First Class rank do not have the Scouting background to fulfill their roles as members of their NYLT patrol and troop. No exceptions to age and rank requirements will be made.

A pre-Conference meeting will be held for all participants and their respective Scoutmasters. Both the participants and their Scoutmasters will be honored at a post-course ceremony in the Fall.

The cost is \$200 and the fee schedule is the same as summer camp. A discount will be available for any scout that will be attending summer camp after NYLT. The fee for summer camp will be \$150.00 if you attend NYLT.
