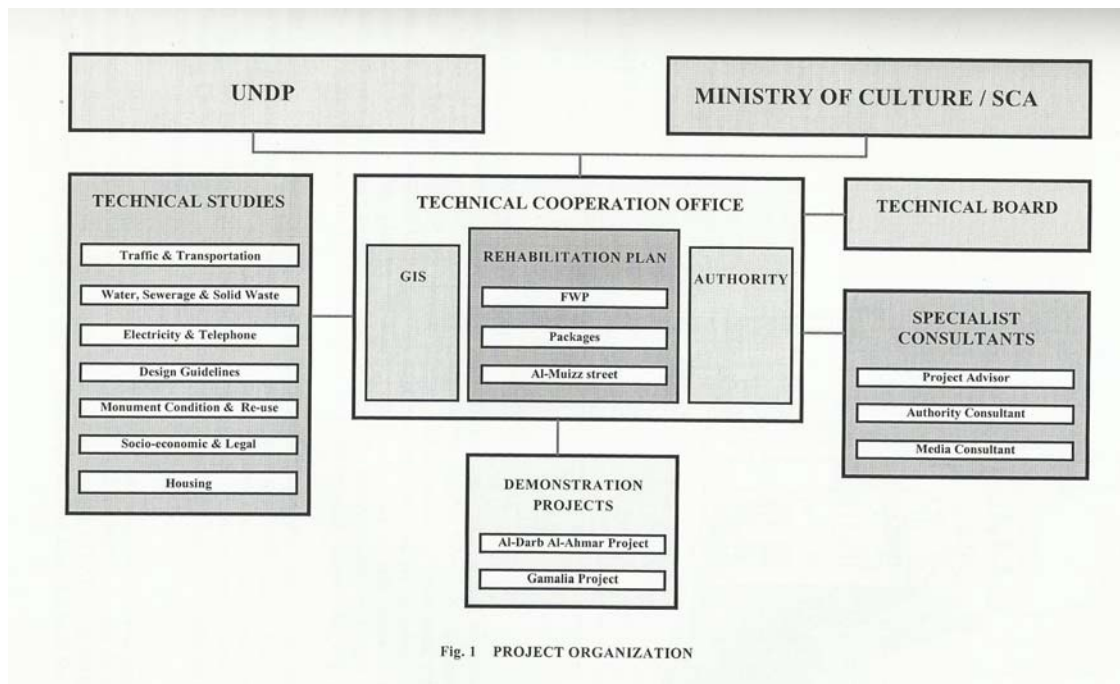

Lecture notes#8: Diagrams and Organizational Charts used in the Planning Process:

1- **The organizational chart:** shows the hierarchy of the administrative structure of the planning team that leads, stirs, and guides the planning process.

2- **The linear (or looped) diagram of the planning process:** shows the rational sequences of the planning process, including all the planning tasks and components; and shows the interrelations and integration between the various planning studies and outputs.

3- **The flowchart diagram of the planning process:** shows, in addition to the previous type, the various divergences in the planning process, based on two or more assumptions, as to answer such question with yes or no; and that where upon a decision would be taken at that specific stage in the planning process.
