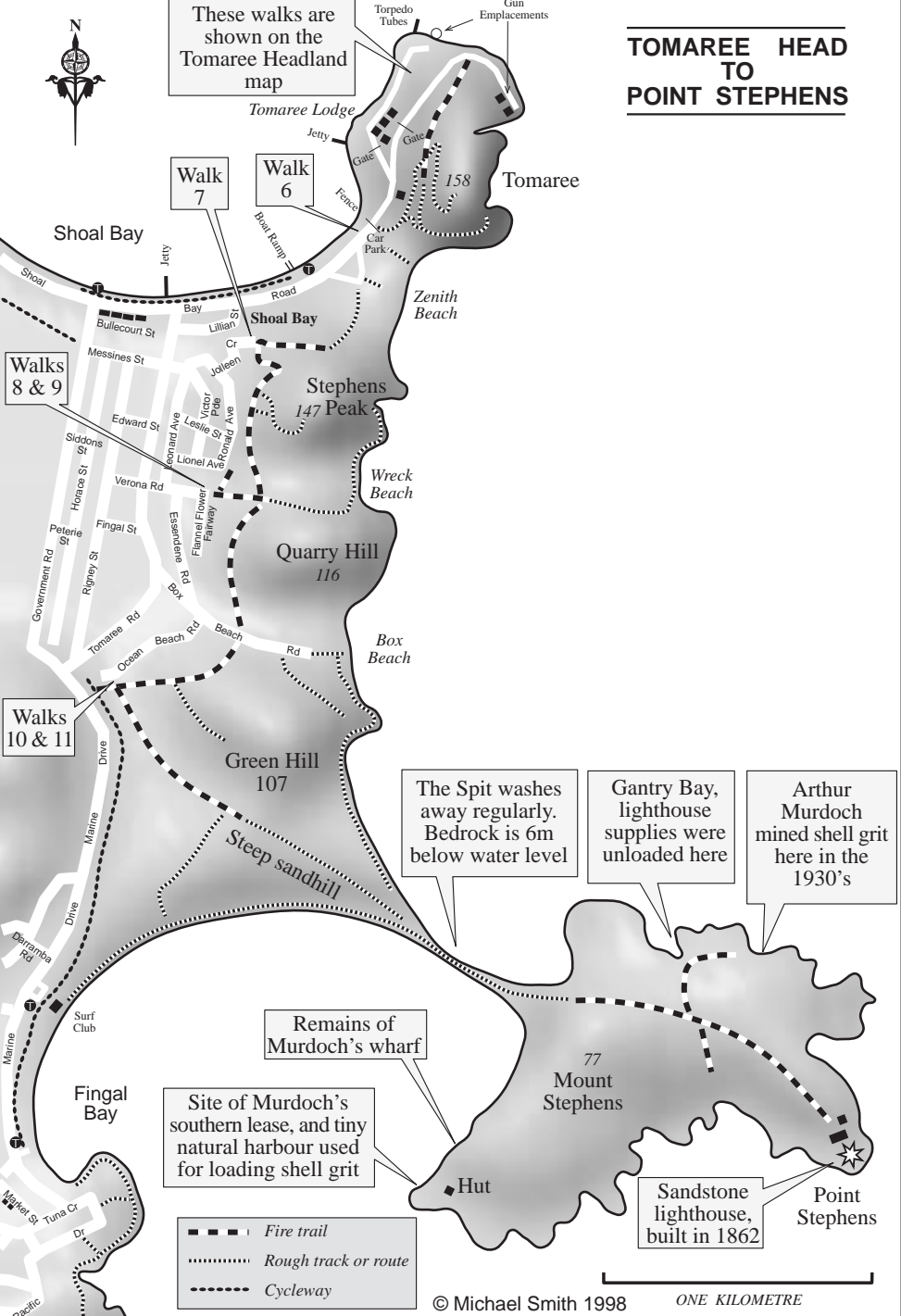




These walks are shown on the Tomaree Headland map
