

Procedure for Selection of Managers and Coaches

Managers are selected according to the following procedure:

- ❑ Managers in good standing of teams from the previous year's baseball season are given the first opportunity to manage during the new baseball season;
- ❑ Vacant positions for teams without managers will be filled by individuals who nominate themselves for a manager's position in writing to the appropriate division Director;
- ❑ Directors will recommend to the Board of Directors (Officers and Directors) who they would want to appoint to the manager's positions;
- ❑ At the February FYAA Meeting, Director's recommendations and all nominations will be voted on by the membership.

All Managers need to complete the Criminal Offense Records Investigation (CORI) application no later than the March FYAA meeting; failure to complete this form by this time may result in suspension from the position as manager.

All Managers must attend monthly membership meetings. If unable to attend, Managers must designate a Team Coach or other Team representative. Teams that do not have representation at the monthly membership meetings risk losing their ability to vote (see FYAA By-Laws, Article II, Section 3) on important matters at FYAA membership meetings. Managers of Teams that cannot be represented by a vote due to lack of adequate attendance at FYAA membership meetings risk being suspended from their position as Manager.

Coaches are selected according to the following procedure:

- ❑ Managers will select their coaches who will be individuals in good standing and submit their names to the appropriate division Director
- ❑ All Coaches need to complete the Criminal Offense Records Investigation (CORI) application no later than the March FYAA meeting; failure to complete this form by this time may result in suspension from the position as coach
