New Business: Projects that need to be done are; Long Pond fields need fence work. KRR needs fence relocated, and batting cages replaced (looking for quote). CP: Green Monster, benches in softball and Babe Ruth dugouts, edge and level Bullock, Pony League field needs edging and infield repaired, and we need a grease trap installed for the kitchen sinks. Phil Rose has checked the Long Pond pitching machine and it needs about \$350 to repair, approved by Dave Brouillette. The money that was raised for Officer Briggs (the Manchester N.H. police officer that was killed in the line of duty) will be used at the family's request to sponsor a \$250 scholarship. (\$220 raised at the concession stand + \$30 put up by the FYAA).
