THIS YEAR WE WILL CELEBRATE THE ELEVENTH ANNUAL WAYNESVILLE FROG FEST. WE WILL HOLD THE EVENT ON MAY 3 & 4, 2008. THE FROG FEST COMMITTEE IS A SMALL VOLUNTARY GROUP THAT ORGANIZES THIS EVENT. BECAUSE OF THIS, WE ASK THAT YOU HELP US IN THE FOLLOWING WAYS:

1. You may set up on Friday, May 2, 2008 between 5:00 P.M. and 7:00 P.M. No Frog Fest Member will be in the Park before that time. On Saturday, May 3, 2008 you can set up after 8:00 A.M. and before 9:45 A.M. At 9:45 A.M. **ALL VEHICLES** must be removed from the main Park road. We ask that if you have to drive on the grass to unload your vehicle, that you take some care. There has been damage in previous years. We are very proud of our park and don't want to create any more work for the three men that take care of it.
2. The main Park road will be closed to all vehicles at 9:45 A.M. and will re-open at 6:30 P.M. No booth is to be removed before 6:00 P.M. If you are staying for the second day, your booth can be left in the park. The Frog Fest Committee is paying for someone to patrol the park from the hours of 7:00 P.M. Saturday until 8:00 A.M. Sunday. The Frog Fest Committee accepts no liability for any theft or damages that might occur. The City does operate an RV Park on the other side of the Roubidoux Creek. Cost is \$13.00 per night. (This is for your information only – we do not take reservations or money for the RV Park). You can start setting up your booth on Sunday after 8:00 A.M. All booths and vehicles should be removed from the park on Sunday after 4:00 P.M unless you receive permission from the Frog Fest Committee to stay later.
3. Booth participants must park in designated areas.
4. If you have difficulties or questions during the day, we or the Waynesville Police will be happy to help. The police will be patrolling the park all day and the Frog Fest Committee will be wearing pins identifying themselves. Our booth will be located at the first pavilion on the right hand side of the road.
5. If you have special announcements or door prize drawings, please write them legibly on paper and give to a Frog Fest Committee member.
6. Electricity is very limited and all outlets are assigned on a first come first serve basis. We need to know amperage and/or wattage of total appliances used. This information

is listed on each appliance on the ledger place (where the serial/model number is listed). Committee will make the final decision whether electricity is provided. Electricity costs \$5.00 per appliance. At this time, there are only THREE 220 hookups but we are hoping that we have at least two more before the festival.

7. PLEASE CLEAN UP YOUR AREA, using the dumpsters available. At the end of the day we could really use some help cleaning up the roads and grandstand area.
8. If you have any questions, please call Rhea Ann Mathews at 573-774-3050. Leave a message if she is not there and she will return your call. Please only call Barb Stinson or Carol Welch at Waynesville City Hall if it an emergency and you have to talk to someone right away at 573-774-6171. These calls are taken during work hours and Frog Fest is not part of a City function; we just happen to work for the City.
