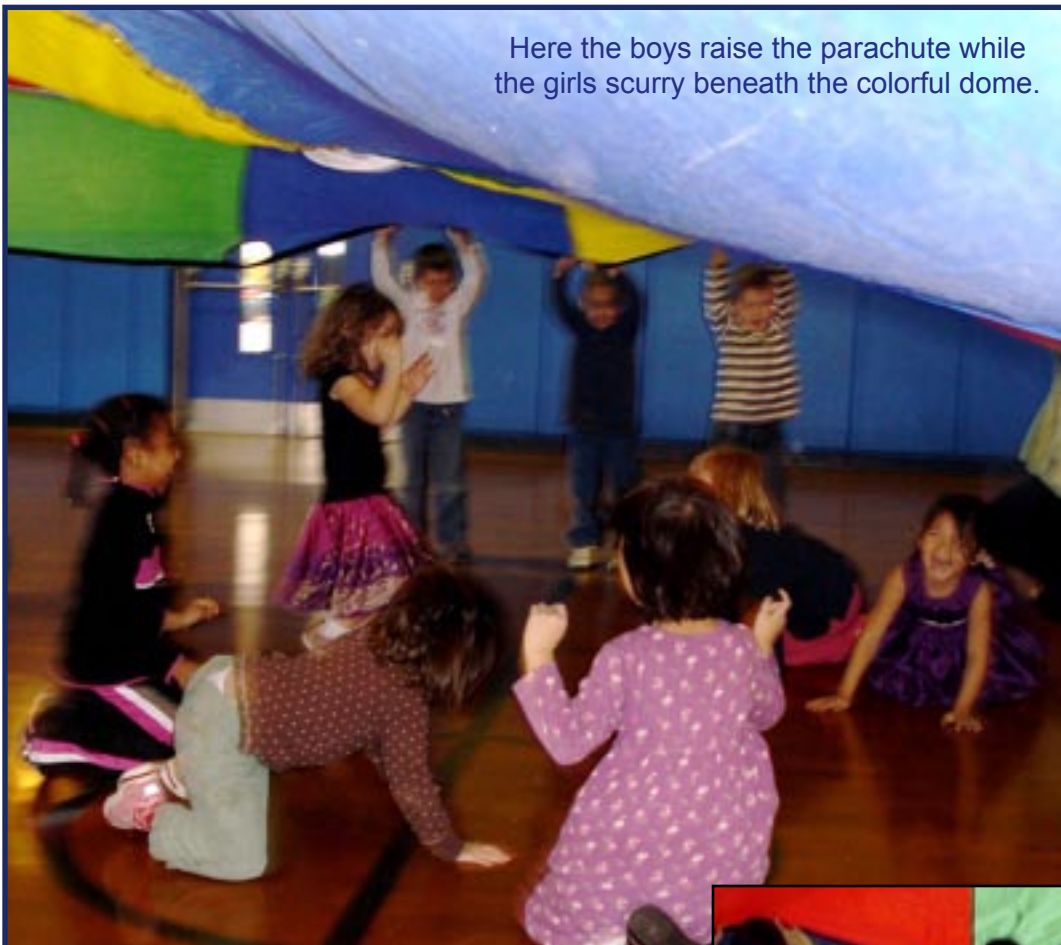

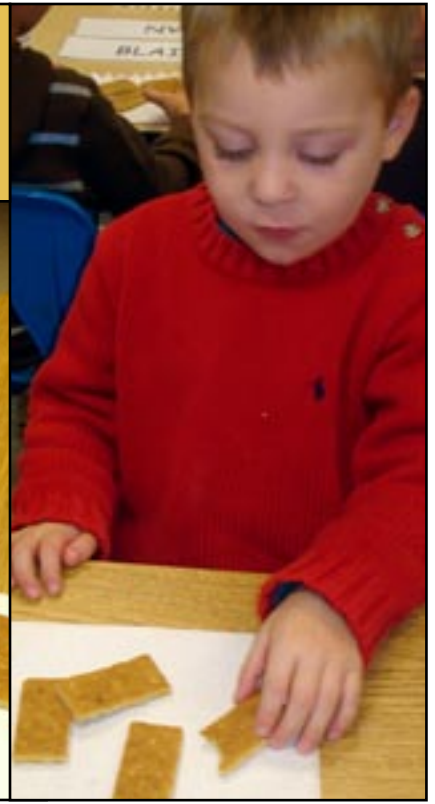




During Friday's visit to the Osage Orange climbing tree at the College, the children stumbled upon some pretty conclusive evidence that squirrels had been there before us!
