

Ft. Campbell Hunting and Fishing Unit Automated Area Assignment Information

1. Signing out for recreation activities:

- a. Recreation areas are assigned telephonically through the Hunting and Fishing Automated Assignment System by calling **(270) 798-0401**. In order to utilize the computer area assignment system you must have a valid Ft. Campbell Post Permit and be registered in the automated system.
 - (1) Menu options lead the patron through the reservation process. Participants are asked to select the desired recreation activity (e.g. hunting, fishing, hiking, etc.), training area and day of activity (no later than two days out).
 - (2) Small Game hunters are allowed to utilize the automated system as a hunting party consisting of 1 to 3 hunters. Small game slots are entered into the system as a hunting block requiring only 1 hunter in each hunting party to sign into the system to reserve the area. The hunter making the reservation in the automated system will be responsible for picking up the area assignment from the Hunting and Fishing Unit. The remaining hunters in the party will be added to the area assignment upon verification of valid Post Permit. The hunter responsible for making the reservation must remain with the hunting party at all times.
 - (3) A list of available training areas, codes and telephone numbers applicable to the process are available at the Hunting and Fishing Unit. Training area availability is subject to change.
- b. Assistance with the automated system is available at the Hunting and Fishing Unit. Patrons must have purchased a Ft. Campbell Post Permit and be registered in the system before assignments may be made.
- c. The following times must be observed when requesting big game and small game hunting area assignments:

0800 – 0900	Active duty military, DAV and dependents of these groups eligible to hunt.
0900 – 1000	All of the above, plus retired military, DAC, ARNG and dependents of these groups eligible to hunt.
1000- closing	All of the above, plus civilians and dependents eligible to hunt
- d. The following time is observed when requesting recreational area assignments other than hunting:

0700 – closing	Active duty military, DAV, retired military, DAC, ARNG, civilians and dependents of these groups 16 years of age and older.

2. Recreational Area Assignment and Rear Area Parking Pass (Area Assignment):

- a. After completing the reservation process an Area Assignment must be obtained from the Hunting and Fishing Unit prior to accessing the rear area. The Area Assignment is a requirement for any person age 16 years and older desiring to participate in any outdoor recreation activity (10 years and older if hunting). It is to be used only by the person whose name appears on the Area Assignment and is valid only for the date, area, and activity specified.
- b. Area Assignments will be available for pick-up during normal business hours upon completion of the reservation process.

3. Turn in of Area Assignment: All Area Assignments must be returned under the following guidelines. In addition, participants signing out through the automated system for any recreation activity must ensure they have signed back into the system no later than 2100 hours the ending day of the activity.

- a. Hunting. All hunting Area Assignments (with the exception of raccoon, fox, and opossum) must be turned in to the Hunting and Fishing Unit not later than 90 minutes after sunset the day of the activity.
- b. Raccoon, fox, and opossum hunters must turn in Area Assignments to the Hunting and Fishing Unit not later than 0900 the morning following the hunt.

NOTE: All small game hunters must report results of their hunt, to include a zero harvest.

- c. Fishing and camping. Fishing Area Assignments must be turned in to the Hunting and Fishing Unit not later than 0900 hours the day following the activity. Camping Area Assignments must be turned in not later than the end of the 72-hour sign out period.
- d. All other activities. Area Assignments for all other activities must be turned in to the Hunting and Fishing Unit not later than 1900 hours the day of the activity.
