NANCY B. CHAMBERS
MEMBER SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

1. The Nancy B. Chambers Member Scholarship was established to assist members of the Georgia Association of Education Office Professionals who are pursuing additional education in the educational office professional field.
2. The Nancy B. Chambers Member Scholarship Committee shall award the scholarship.
3. The Nancy B. Chambers Member Scholarship is a tuition only scholarship; value is tied to tuition to be paid by the recipient.
4. Scholarship applicants shall be evaluated by the committee on the following criteria:
 - a. Applicant must have been a GAEOP member for three years immediately preceding the date of the scholarship application deadline.
 - b. Applicant must provide two letters of recommendation:
 - Letter, from someone in your local organization describing your leadership record, character, personality.
 - Letter from someone in your community who knows you.
 - c. Applicant must be enrolling in a program of study related to the educational office field.
 - d. GAEOP members may apply for a scholarship award as many times as desired. In order to be eligible for a second or subsequent scholarship award, the applicant must have maintained at least a 2.8 (of a possible 4.0) grade point average during the term for which the previous scholarship award was made.
 - e. Completed application must be submitted to the Nancy B. Chambers Member Scholarship Chairman, postmarked no later than March 29, 2003.
5. The maximum value of the scholarship shall be \$500.
6. The approved money will be valid for the academic year following the awarding of the scholarship.
7. Payment for the scholarship will be made directly to the institution upon receipt of documentation or registration from the educational institution showing intent of enrollment.

8. A rating system of 100 points shall be used in determining the scholarship recipient.
 - Up to 30 points may be awarded for participation and leadership positions in local educational office personnel associations, GAEOP and/or NAEOP.
 - Up to 50 points may be awarded for past academic performance based on SAT scores, ACT scores, or transcripts of previous coursework.
 - Up to 20 points may be awarded for nearness to completion of degree or work toward a PSP certificate.
