The revision of the GAEOP Bylaws has passed. During the coming year, the Executive Board will continue to put these revisions into effect.

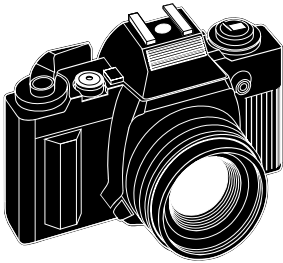
