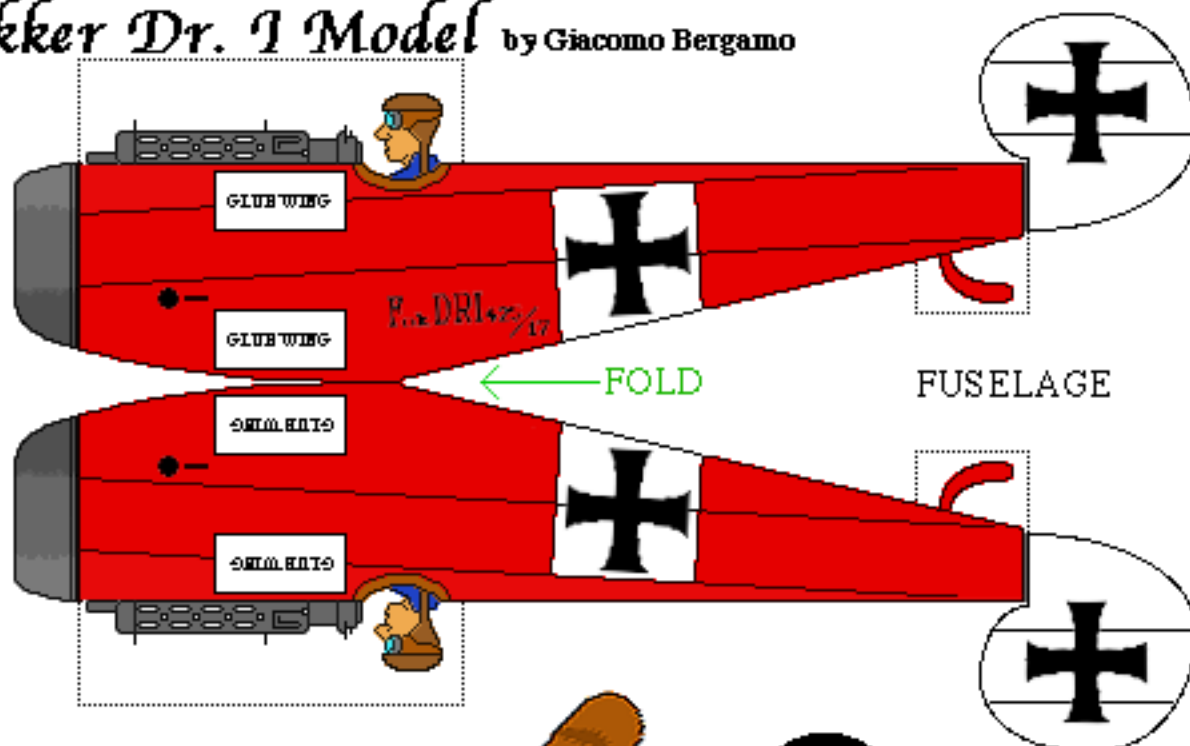
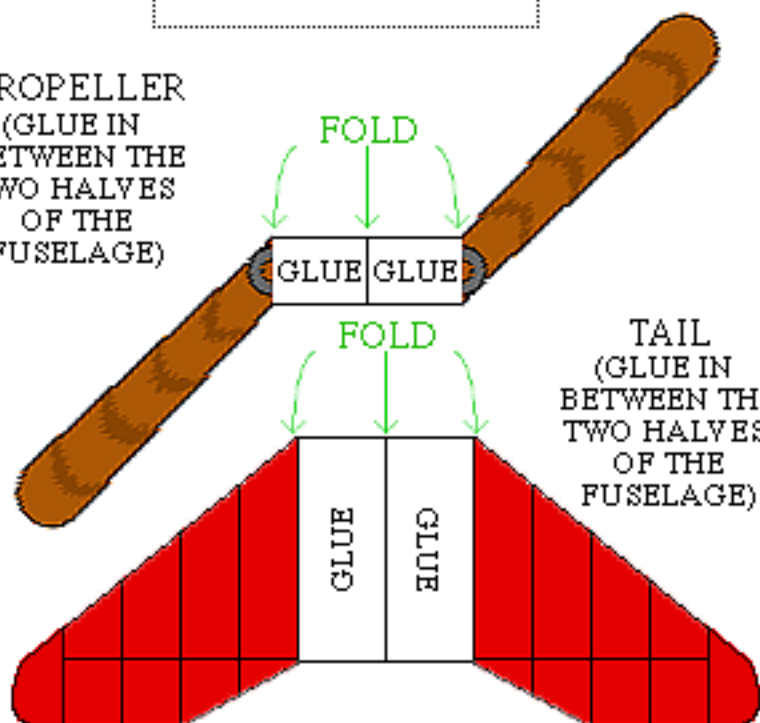


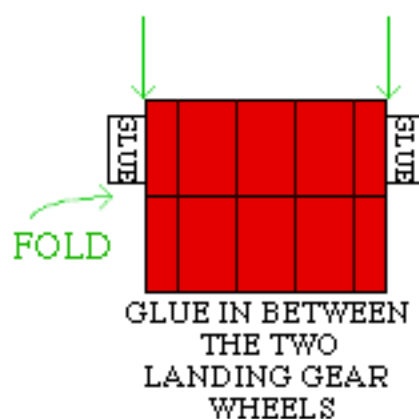
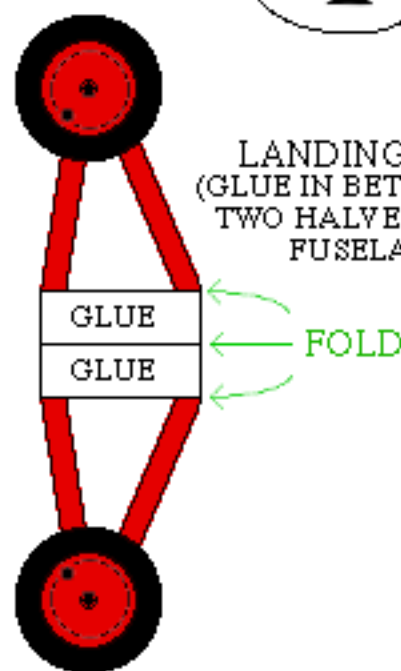

## THE WAR IN THE SKIES DURING WORLD WAR ONE *by Giacomo Bergamo*

It was in World War One that aerial warfare became common. Both zeppelins and airplanes were used in WWI. Aerial warfare became even more deadly when machine guns synchronized with the propellers of planes allowed pilots to shoot directly ahead. Planes were also able to find enemy positions and bomb them from the air.

World War One also produced a number of famous aces, pilots who had shot down at least five enemy planes. The most famous was the German pilot von Richthofen, known as the "Red Baron" because of the color of his plane, who flew a Fokker Dr. I and shot down 80 planes of the Allies.
