- 1) Independent back falling gates will be used for all starts
- 2) Riders representative is to be selected at riders briefing, as per rule 3-14
- 3) The protest committee will consist of Steward, Riders Rep and Clerk Of The Course.
- 4) Minimum of 6 riders and a maximum of 30 riders per class.
- 5) The organisers reserve the right to alter or change classes subject to entries.
- 6) Modifications as per rule 15-15-5 (Mini licenced only)
- 7) Race numbers as per rule 10-2-2
- 8) No sharing of bikes as some classes may be combined.
- 9) Random noise testing may be carried out.
- 10) Attendance of all riders at the riders briefing is compulsory, roll call to be held.
- 11) Parents of all mini licenced riders are expected to guide, support and assist their children to participate safely in and enjoy the sport. As per rule 15-8.
- 12) Each rider may only enter one class.
