Supplementary Rules

Entry Fee: An initial Series fee of \$60 per class, then \$45 per class for each round, payable to host club on the day.

This includes the hire of a transponder for the day. If you have your own transponder, subtract \$5 from the daily entry fee. (\$40)

Mini: Initial Series fee \$40 per class then \$30 per class for each round, payable to host club on the day. (Note: not transponder timed)

Two Class Entry \$100 Series fee

Family discounts \$60 for the first entry, \$30 for each additional family member.

⇒ Late entries \$100

⇒ Late entries and class changes must be received at least 7 days before the day of the event.

⇒ Riders must include a new and full entry fee with any request to change class mid-series.

Competitors must hold a current MNZ competition licence.
DAY LICENCES will NOT be available at Series Rounds.

Entries WILL NOT be accepted on the day of any Series round.

Entries will be accepted between rounds, depending on numbers.

CLASSES (note you may enter more than one class on same bike as long as it fits the cc)

- MX1 301cc plus 4-stroke, 251cc plus 2-stroke
- MX2 up to 300cc 4-stroke, up to 250cc 2-stroke
- INTERMEDIATE any cc
- VETERANS 35yrs plus (*Will be split if entries exceed 40 – please fill in your age on the entry form*)
- JUNIOR 8-11yrs 85cc up to 125cc 4-stroke, up to 85cc 2-stroke
(Parents - please note that junior competitors are required to ride the same track as senior riders and therefore need to possess a reasonable skill level which will enable them to negotiate the tracks safely).
- JUNIOR 12-16yrs 85cc up to 150cc 4-stroke, up to 85cc 2-stroke
- JUNIOR 12-16yrs 125cc 125cc 2-stroke MX
- JUNIOR 14-16yrs 250cc 250cc 4-stroke MX
- MINI 4-5yrs Introduction
- MINI 6-8yrs Introduction
- Mini 6-8yrs MX
- MINI 7-11yrs Trail
- Mini 7-8yrs 65cc
- MINI 9-11yrs 65cc

Note Minimum of 6 riders per class

At the discretion of the series committee & subject to entry numbers & safety, some classes may be either combined to become one or run together with a split start.

JUNIORS

Please refer to rule 15-2-5

(A) Subject to rule 15-2-5(B), except for those turning 17, in age based competition, the age of a junior competitor on the first day of an event or series shall determine his/her age group for that event or series.

(B) If a junior competitor's birthday falls during an event or series (s)he may commence and complete that event or series in the next age group. However, nothing in this rule shall entitle a junior competitor to ride a capacity or type of junior machine under age.

The exception being if a Junior rider turns 17yrs midway through the Series. In this case the rider must enter the Senior class at the start of the Series on a Senior licence.

ALL RIDERS

Your start position for each moto will be determined by either your practice times or the result of your previous race.

NUMBERS

Even though we have electronic timing, numbers are still necessary for a number of reasons, not least, as a backup system.

Numbers must be **BOLD** on **NON GLOSS CONTRASTING BACKGROUNDS** as per rule 10-3

Please make sure your back numbers are clear also.

TRANSPONDERS

Transponder timing will be used throughout the Series. Please subtract \$5 from your entry fee if you have your own transponder.

96dBA NOISE LEVEL LIMIT

As from the 1st June, all motorcycles must be under the maximum noise level of 96dBA. All clubs have been issued noise meters and random testing will be undertaken at Series rounds.

1. I, the undersigned, declare that the motorcycle/s that I have entered for this event is/are in good condition and comply with all the rules as set down by the MNZ Manual of Sport. I take full responsibility in respect of the conditions as set down, and also understand that a spot check may take place on any motorcycle before, during or after the event for safety and other reasons.
2. I shall abide by any decision directed at me by the Steward of the meeting.
3. I understand that any competitor making a false declaration may be disqualified from the event.
4. I have read the Supplementary Regulations for this competition and agree to be bound by them and the General Rules of Motorcycling NZ Inc.
5. I am aware that the sport of motorcycling might,
 - a. Cause me injury, serious or otherwise.
 - b. Damage my property.
6. I wish to take part in the Central Otago MCC, Gore and Districts MCC, Southland MCC, South Otago MCC & Mosgiel and Districts MCC ie. (The Southern Moto-X Series) event, despite the above risks.
7. Neither I, nor anyone associated or connected with me, will make any claim against you or your officers, employees or agents in respect of:
 - a. Any injury suffered by me, or
 - b. Any damage to any of my property regardless of how the injury or damage occurs.
8. I will indemnify you against all claims, damages or losses (including costs) which you incur as the direct or indirect result of any injury to me or damage to my property.
9. I am physically fit and there is no health or other reason why I should not participate in the sport of Motorcycle Competition.
10. I am aware that this disclaimer will not affect any legal obligations you have to me which you cannot contract out of under New Zealand law.
11. I agree that in this disclaimer "my property" includes any property owned by me or in my possession or under my control.
12. I agree that this disclaimer will be binding on my family, my heirs, my legal assigns and my administrators and executors.
13. I accept that stripping and re-assembly for Technical Checks are at my cost.
