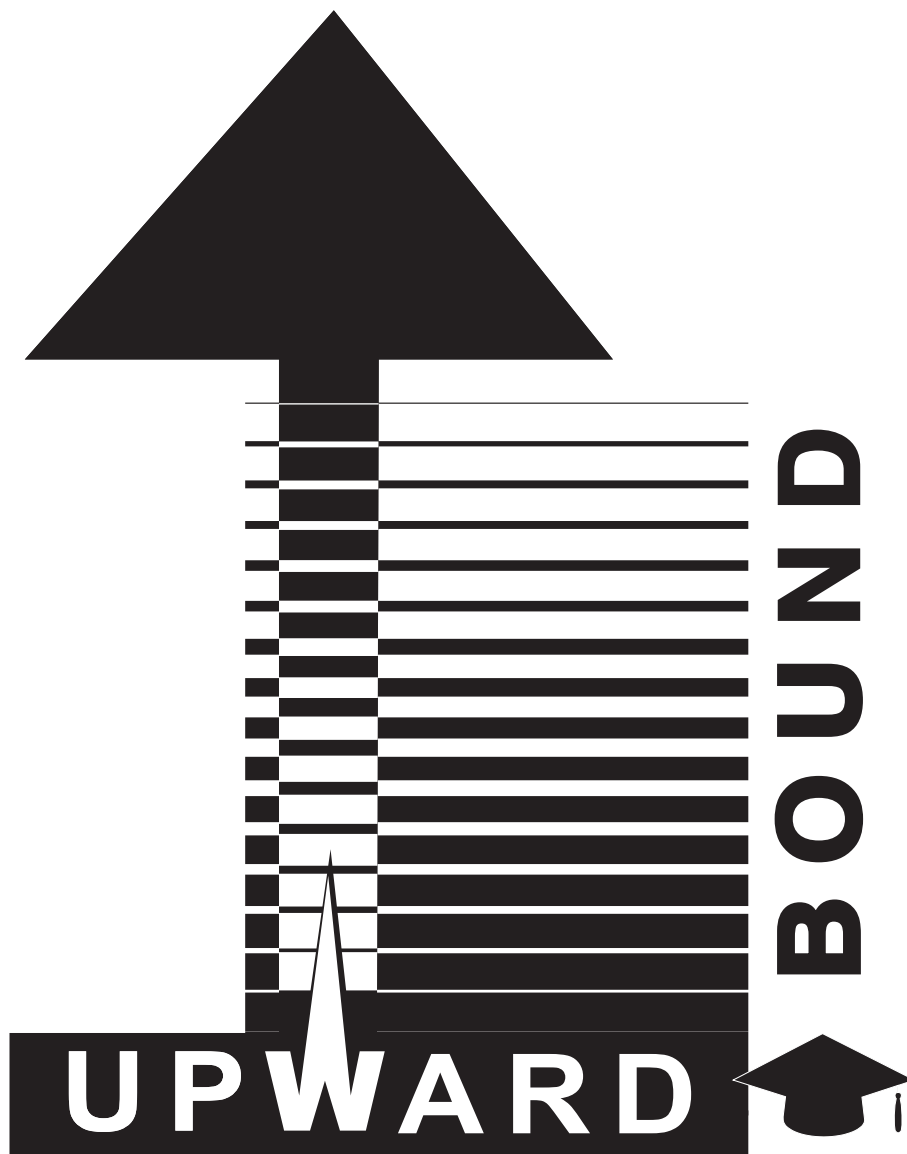

WHAT IS UPWARD BOUND?

Upward Bound was created by the 1964 Economic Opportunities Act. A year later, Upward Bound joined two other special programs for students from disadvantaged backgrounds, Talent Search and Student Support Services, under authorization of title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965. The three programs were referred to as “TRIO.”

Upward Bound generates skills and motivation necessary for success in education beyond high school among low-income and potential first generation college students who are enrolled in high school.

Upward Bound provides tutors to assist the students with their homework and the improvement of academic skills, plans social, cultural and recreational activities each month; and offers individual counseling for students who have personal or academic problems.

Program participants are required to attend their high school classes, Upward Bound activities, tutoring sessions, meet regularly with their Upward Bound Advisor, and strive to improve their academic skills and maintain a 3.00 G.P.A. During the Summer Academy, students are required to follow the Rules of Student Conduct established by Upward Bound. In addition, each student will be required to take diagnostic and progress tests.

The Chemeketa Community College Upward Bound program is funded by the US Department of Education to raise college entrance and graduation rates in Marion County. This is a year-round educational experience. Upward Bound students are required to attend scheduled Upward Bound classes and/or weekly workshops, participate in program travel, attend after-school tutoring and participate in the six-week Summer Academy held on the Chemeketa Community College Campus.

It is important that students, as well as their parents, fully understand the commitment they are making to the Upward Bound Program and the investment the program is making in each participant.
