Michael Blevins (Artistic Director ~ Co-Founder): Broadway credits include: Bring Back Birdie, Little Me and The Tap Dance Kid. Film credits include: Richard Attenborough's Chaplin, "Mark" in the film A Chorus Line, and Woody Allen's Zelig. Blevins has worked with many Tony & Oscar winning directors and performers such as: Bob Fosse, Vivian Matalon, Michael Douglas, Chita Rivera, Diane Lane and Bebe Neuwirth. He has gained international recognition as an arts educator having trained such Broadway luminaries as Savion Glover & Melissa Errico. Teaching credits also include: the K-12 public school system, NYU's Tisch School of the Arts exclusive studio program, Broadway Dance Center, Folkuniversitete Balettakademien under the artistic direction of Lia Schubert in Gothenborg, Sweden, and created the Musical Theatre Works Academy with the legendary Gwen Verdon. Mr. Blevins attended the University of North Carolina & continued his training in the performing arts at NYU's Tisch School of the Arts.

Justin Boccitto (Executive Producer ~ Co-Founder): attended Circle in the Square Theatre School and has appeared at The Metropolitan Opera, The New York Theatre Ballet, Papermill Playhouse, NJPAC, The Drama League's Salute to Chita Rivera and with the Willow Cabin Theatre Company. He recently finished assisting Nicole Fosse on a new dance piece in NYC and is currently choreographer for the Westchester Broadway Theatre's Young Artists Program. Justin has instructed master classes for The Juilliard School, Circle in the Square Theatre School, Wingspan Arts and is on the faculty of Astoria Dance Centre where he co-founded The New Stage, a musical theatre program for young artists. Justin assists Michael Blevins at Broadway Dance Center in Manhattan and is a founding member of Generation Tap.

ABOUT THE GROUP THEATRE TOO

Inspired by the 1930's Group Theatre, Michael Blevins and Justin Boccitto formed The Group Theatre Too [GTT] in New York City in 2003. The company is a theatre collective comprised of a permanent ensemble of artists dedicated to dramatizing the life of their times through original American pieces, classic and contemporary plays, musicals, one-act festivals, cabaret and dance pieces. The Group Theatre Too produces quality entertainment that stimulates and supports an ensemble of artists as well as the general public through productions, outreach, and educational performing art programs for both youths and adults.

• VISION:

~ Stage professional entertainment that touches on current social issues and reflects American generations.

~ Create theatre that is affordable and speaks to and for its audience.

~ Collaboration in mounting pieces that exemplify the ensemble approach.

• METHODOLOGY:

~ Observe the components of mythological structure.

~ Support an inner emotional process that is honest, in-moment, and collaborative.

~ Pass this Methodology along through educational and intern programs.

• MEMBERSHIP:

Company members enjoy life-long membership to a theatre collective that is dedicated to the close criticism of its members' work. Each year only a handful of artists are accepted and participate in an environment where they can experiment with their craft and might not otherwise have the chance to create. In addition to performance, GTT is a place to concentrate on process and offers this setting for actors, playwrights, composers, lyricists, singers, choreographers, dancers, and directors to further develop their arts.

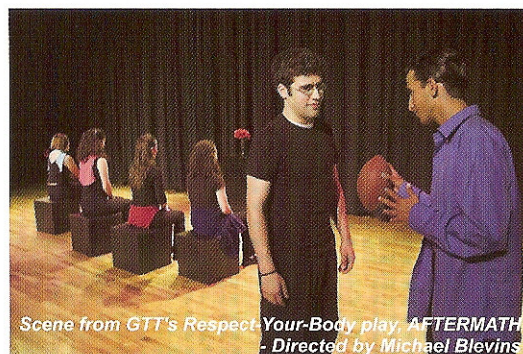

The cast consists of professional New York actors, who have played to over 5,000 school students.

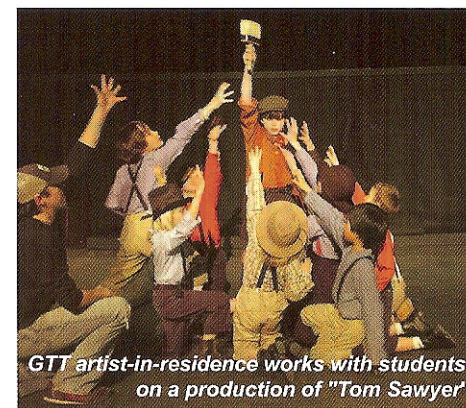


Scene from GTT's Respect-Your-Body play, AFTERMATH
