We also made our own Easter Bunny paper basket and filled it with candy — which we ate immediately, of course!

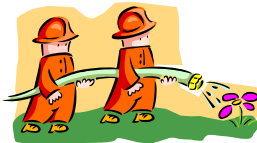
We visited Peppermint Place and saw candy being made. It was a real treat!
