soon as it is earned and we will pick up the patch.

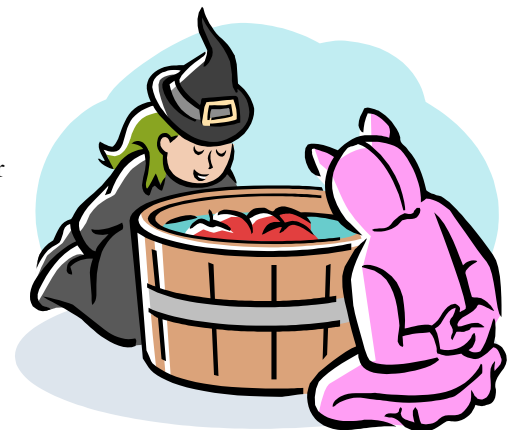
If your daughter has something that she really wants to do or learn about please let us know.
