At the April Volunteer Dinner, you need to turn in a complete printed list of girls Bridging to the next level to Lori Ellison.

Also – you need to:

Make a 3x5 index card for each scout bridging and each leader attending the ceremony. Each card should have one name and the troop number on it. The cards will be used for assigned seating for your troop.

You should begin practicing your age level song with your troop. **At bridging there will be no song sheets for the girls to use on stage. The girls should have them memorized.** Most of the songs the girls will sing are available on CD's that the service unit has.

All scouts who are members of your troop are invited to attend the Bridging Ceremony. We need scouts to participate in the flag ceremony, scouts to pass out programs and

scouts to act as greeters for the bridging scouts. These girls should not be bridging. Please return the third page of this flyer if you have any scouts willing to help.

Each scout will need a permission slip to attend both the Rehearsal and the Bridging Ceremony Activities. We suggest you collect the permission slips before the respective nights of each activity.

On the night of the Bridging Ceremony, we will be giving all the scouts who bridge a carnation. They will be located on a table on the stage behind the curtains. You need to collect these before the ceremony begins.

On the night of Bridging each leader should bring:

A basket to hold the carnations

An index card (or something like it) with each scouts name and troop number on it.

You should tape to each card:

Bridging Patch (only for scouts who have completed the actual bridging activities)

Any other appropriate pins (year membership pin, next level pins, etc...), badges or insignias
