UNNATURE HIKE:

Choose a wooded area or nature trail and set up unnatural things, either man-made or natural things out of place (driftwood or shells in a forest, etc.). Girls have notepads or piece of paper to write down answers. They walk the unnatural trail and write down things out of place, (piece of carrot, pen, red string, plastic knife, toothbrush, comb, etc.). After a given period of time the girl with the most correct answers wins. (Send a few girls through the area at a time---no talking and don't stop when you see something unusual or let anyone see your list).

NATURE ABC:

On this hike have the girls identify nature items they see starting with the letter A, then B, etc. For example: A for acorn, B for bee, C for cobweb, etc.

COLORS:

Have the girls record on a piece of paper how many different colors they see on their hike. You could use trees, plants, etc.
