

Stretch your fingers and measure from tip of thumb to little finger (span).
Contribute 5 cents per inch.

Measure from tip of fingers to elbow. Contribute 2 cents per inch.

Contribute 2 cents per inch of your height.

Measure your foot from toe to heel. Contribute 3 cents per inch.

Measure your foot from toe to heel. Contribute 1 cent per centimeter.

Contribute 2 cents per word in the "Brownie Smile Song".

Multiply the number of our Service Unit by 10 cents and contribute that amount.

How old is Girl Scouts of the USA? Contribute 1 cent per year.

Contribute 3 cents per year of your age.

Measure the length of your hair. Contribute 3 cents per inch.

Contribute 5 cents per word in "Make New Friends".

Contribute 4 cents per person in your group.

Put in 5 cents per girl in the first Girl Scout troop in the US.

Put in 5 cents per inch of your waist measurement.

Stretch your arms out to the side and measure the distance from one hand to the other. Put in 2 cents per inch.

Measure the length of each of your fingers. Add them up and put in 1 cent for each inch.

Put in 5 cents for the number of times you can jump rope in a minute.

Figure the total number of years your group has in Girl Scouting. Put in 1 cent for the total number of years.

Stand shoulder to shoulder and measure that distance. Put in 1 cent per inch.

Put in 1 cent per second you can hop on one foot.

Add the digits in your troop number. (175 is $1+7+5=13$) Put in 5 cents for the total.

Put in 1 cent per piece of insignia on your uniform.

Put in 1 cent for every year old you are.

Each girl tells how many brothers and sisters she has. Add those numbers and put in 1 cent for each brother and sister.

Add the total number of pets in the troop and put in 1 cent per each pet.

Contribute 5 cents for each Girl Scout Law.

Contribute 2 cents for every button on your clothing.

Contribute 1 cent for every badge/patch you have earned.

Contribute 5 cents for each year you've been in Girl Scouts.

Contribute 5 cents for each girl in your troop.

Contribute 10 cents for each Try-It your troop has earned this year.

Contribute 10 cents for each hour of community service your troop has done this year.

Contribute 10 cents each for the number of requirements needed to earn a Junior badge.

Figure the average age of the girls in your troop. Contribute 2 cents per year.

Match the highest amount contributed so far.

How many varieties of cookies do we sell? Multiply this number by 10 cents and contribute the answer.

Measure your height by your hand span. Multiply that number by 5 cents and contribute the answer.

Contribute 5 cents for each membership star in your troop.
