

Young Naturalists Program

The fall program includes 8 sessions: 1 Friday evening & 6 Saturday mornings at the Guelph Lake Nature Centre, plus 1 Saturday morning off-site. The leaders will provide instruction and lots of activity. Kids will



be making crafts, catching and identifying bugs, and checking out plants, animal tracks, and birds. **Fall program** begins on Saturday, September 15, 2007, from 10:00 a.m. to noon, and continues on alternate Saturday mornings through December 8th. The last session will meet

on Friday evening, December 21, 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., for a campfire cookout and star gazing.

The cost is \$25.00 per child for the Fall program, to a maximum of \$50.00 per family, if more than 2 children are enrolled in the same program. The cost for the longer Winter program is \$35.00 per child, to a maximum of \$70.00 per family.
