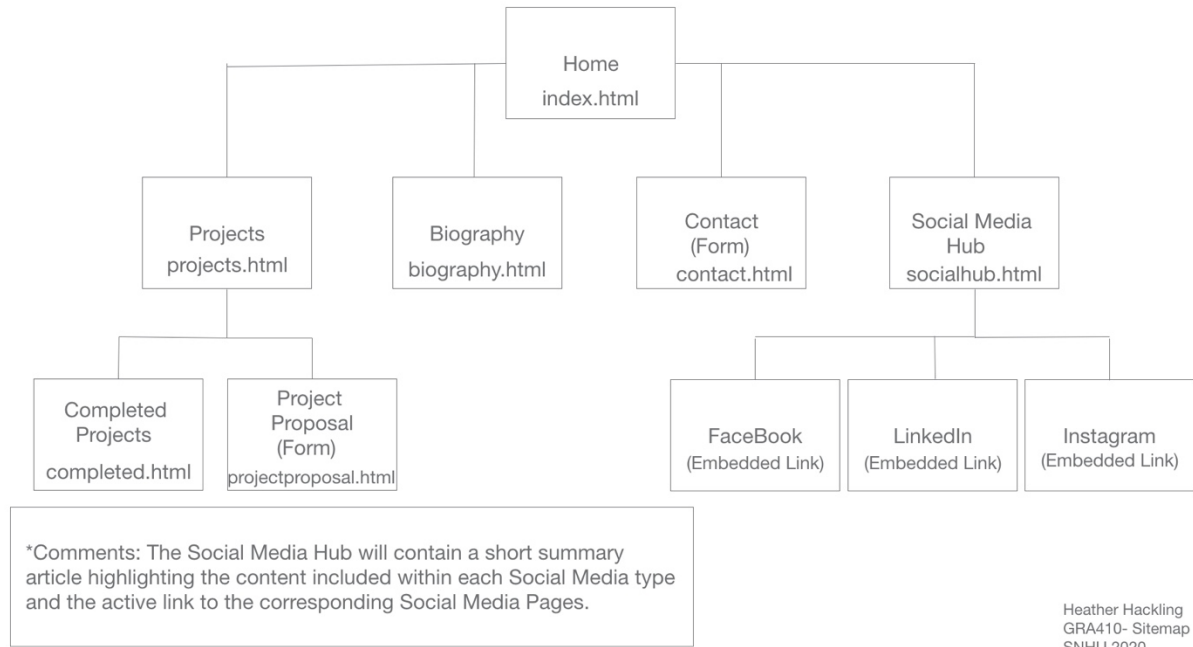

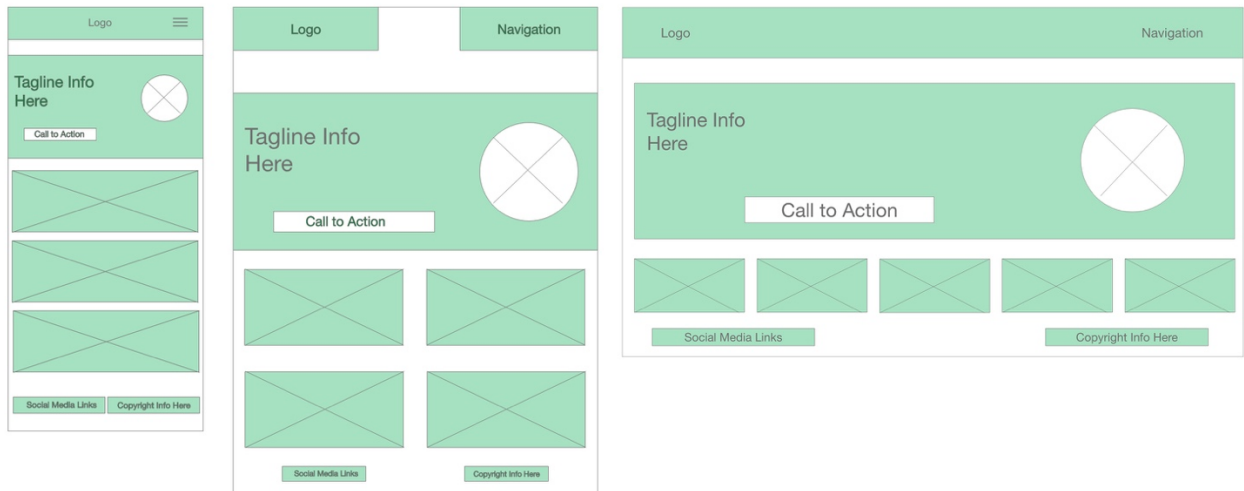
Sitemap

Wireframe Breakpoints



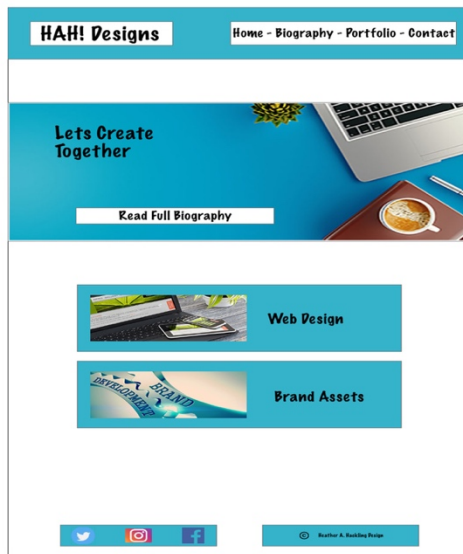
Comments:

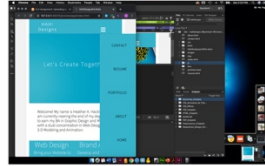

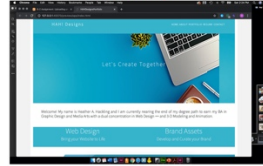

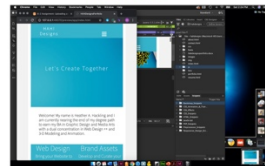
Nav Flyout



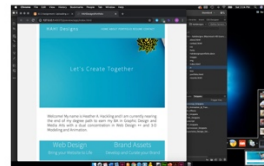
Desktop



Mobile



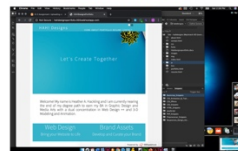
Tablet



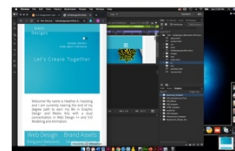
Live Desktop
