**NOTICE OF COMMENCEMENT OF CHAPTER 11 CASE  
AND NOTICE OF HEARINGS ON FIRST DAY MOTIONS**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that on April 20, 2023, M. Burton Marshall a/k/a Miles Burton Marshall, the debtor and debtor in possession (the "Debtor"), commenced a case under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of New York, Utica Division (the "Court"). The case has been assigned to the Honorable Robert E. Littlefield.

**PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that in connection with the Debtor's Chapter 11 case, telephonic hearing (the "Hearings") to consider the Debtor's first day motions (the "First Day Motions") have been scheduled for **April 24, 2023 at 9:30 a.m. before the Honorable Robert E. **PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that at the Hearings, the Debtor will move the Court for entry of orders in connection with the following First Day Motions:

- Motion for Order Pursuant to Sections 105(a), 363(c), 345(b), and 364(a) of the Bankruptcy Code Authorizing Debtor (I) to Continue to Use Existing Cash Management System, and (II) to Maintain Existing Bank Accounts;
- Debtor's Emergency Motion for Entry of an Order: (I) Authorizing Debtor to Use Cash Collateral on an Interim Basis; (II) Granting Adequate Protection Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105, 361, and 363; (III) Modifying the Automatic Stay; (IV) Scheduling Final Hearing; and (V) Granting Related Relief;
- Motion Pursuant to Sections 105(a) and 363(b) of the Bankruptcy Code for an Order Authorizing Payment of Wages, Compensation, and Employee Benefits; and
