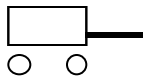
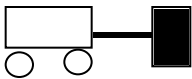
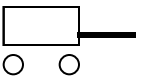
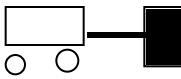
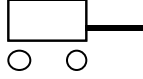
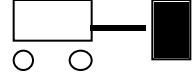
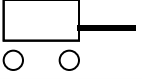
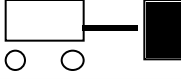
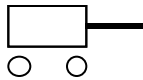
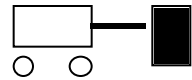
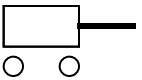
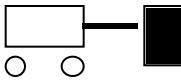


Bouncing Cart—Change in Kinetic Energy ⁶⁰
