Reading of Membership Application

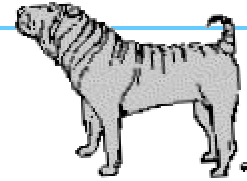
Deb did a second reading of Randi Hinshaw's application and she was voted in the club.
