Old business: The dance had a profit of \$ 497.00. Derrick will be auditing the treasurer's books tonight. Sue is working on the federal tax form 990. Dana has filed the 2009 MN Non Profit Annual report.

New Business: Carole presented a proposal in regards to a clinic given by Ruby Kennedy. Estimated cost is \$ 175 for a 2 day event with \$ 40.00 - \$ 50.00 stalling charge depending on where the event would be held. Possible locations are Simons or Cornerstone. Discussed were options of having the club pay a portion of the charge on members attending for educational reimbursement. More info & details will follow.

The buckets we will be using for first place at the open show have arrived. A sample of the stickers with the clubs logo that will be on each bucket were brought in. There was enough interest that we will order additional stickers and sell to club members interested to put on their trucks, trailers, etc.

It was brought up that St Croix Riders saddle club is interested in joining GCSCA. The club voted "yes" and this vote will be brought back to the County at their next meeting.

Lisa Paquet would like to pursue the possibility of adding overnight camping spots at the Hay Creek rec center. Another possible location of Frontenac State Park was mentioned.

The saddle club will sponser a table at the Pierce County 4-H Spaghetti fundraiser on Saturday, March 21st. This will be to promote the club and let others know what we are all about.
