

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. If I signed up and I'm unable to play do I still have to pay?

A. Depends, once you sign up you have to pay unless the club is notified and the course refunds the money or you cancel before the last day to sign up posted on the HDC golf schedule.

Q. Can I bring a guest?

A. Yes, you are allowed to bring the same guest twice
(*This affords your guest a preview of the HDC Golf Club*)

Q. Can my guest be bumped for an HDC member?

A. Yes, HDC Club Members have first priority and guest can be bumped at any time.

Q. Can a guest play in the \$5 bonus holes?

A. Guest can't play in regular tournament play but they can play in non tournament play
(*Example: Laughlin, Reno & Christmas Shutdown*)

Q. Can guest play in the regular closest to the pin, long drive and long putt?

A. Guest can't play in regular tournament play but they can play in non tournament play
Since they can only play twice as a guest, this shouldn't be any inconvenience
(*example: Laughlin, Reno & Christmas Shutdown*)

Q. If it's raining do we still play golf?

A. Golf is played unless the course deems it unplayable; HDC Golf Club has nothing to do with it.
(*You can always call the course (number located on the tee time sheet) to check if the tournament is canceled*)

Q. Do I have to post my score after an HDC event?

A. Yes, you are required to post all your scores.
(*this is not our handicapper Charlie Schrauth's job*)

Q. Do I have to post my score after I played a round of golf outside an HDC event?

A. Yes, you are required to post all your scores. Playing with the HDC or just for fun, all scores must be posted even if you shot a bad round.
