Angus has acted for over thirty years both in Britain (including eight years of appearances at the Edinburgh International Arts Festival) and in the US playing such roles as Cyrano, Othello, Salieri (*Amadeus*), Ishmael (*Moby Dick*), Harry (*Home*), Sparger (*Kennedy's Children*), The Player (*Rosenkrantz and Guildenstern are Dead*). Locally, he has appeared as Frank Doel (*84 Charing Cross Road*), Matt (*Talley's Folly*), Lenny (*Rumors*), George (*Virginia Woolf*), Captain Bluntschli (*Arms and the Man*), and Henry (*The Real Thing*), with Peekskill Repertory Theatre; as Mr. Rice (*Molly Sweeney*) and Thomas Dunne (*The Steward of Christendom*) with Bluestone Actors Project; as Tom (*Skylight*) and The Man (*Unexpected Man*) with Off-the-Cuff Productions, as Carr Gomm (*The Elephant Man*) with Synapse Productions, as the Duke of York in *Richard II* with York Shakespeare, and most recently as The Father in the Strindberg play of the same name (2002 OOB award) with Yahoo Escadrille. He has also appeared regularly over the past three years in the Applause Books First Folio Shakespeare Marathon readings. His wife, Stephanie, and children, James and Jennifer, are also in theatre.
