What: Dollars for Scholars volunteers, students and anyone who believes in increasing access to postsecondary education will gather for a 5k walk at UCSD, and enjoy a College Fair, entertainment and raffle prizes. Dollars for Scholars chapter volunteers will keep 100 percent of what they raise for their scholarship programs.

When & Where: Saturday, November 3, 2007. Times: 9:00 a.m. registration, 10:00 a.m. walk start. From the I-5, exit La Jolla Village Drive, go west. Turn right on Villa La Jolla Drive. Turn left on Gilman Drive. Turn left into Parking Lot 602 (look for directional signs). The registration and race start area will be in the School of Medicine lawn.
