

INDIAN FORK BAPTIST CHURCH CEMETERY C-11

LOCATION: From Bagdad, Ky., drive northeast on Ky. 12 for 1.9 miles. The church and cemetery are on the left next to the highway.

CONDITION: The Indian Fork Baptist Church was established in 1806. The cemetery occupies about one-half acre on the south side of the building. The grounds are well maintained and most of the markers are in good condition. In an effort to make it easier to mow the area, most of the foot markers appear to have been taken up and the fieldstones which marked some graves have been laid flat on the ground. The rows begin on the south side of the cemetery and the graves in each row are listed starting on the east side. This survey was made on October 15, 1978.

EASLEY CEMETERY E-20

LOCATION: Drive to Harrisonville, Ky. Just before entering the town from the west turn right into the farm now owned by Thomas Lewis. Follow the gravel farm road south for 600 feet. The cemetery is located in a grove of trees about 30 feet south of this point.

CONDITION: This cemetery covers an area measuring 50' x 65' and is not protected by a fence. There are a number of small trees and a moderate amount of underbrush within the site. In addition to the stones listed, the survey located nine graves marked by fieldstones. This survey was made on July 9, 1978.

- 1... C. K. EASLEY/Born/Apr. 27, 1842/Died/Feb. 13, 1894/Gone to a bright home/Where grief cannot come. — This is an obelisk type stone standing about 5' high. Above the name there is a sculpture of the symbol of the Masonic Order and on the base the name EASLEY is carved.
- 2... SARAH U./WIFE OF/C. K. EASLEY/BORN/JULY 19, 1846/DIED/APR. 19, 1879 — SD.
- 3... JUDITH H/DAUT. OF/J. & E. EASLEY,/BORN/Apr. 24, 1848/DIED/June 28, 1866.
- 4... JOHN P./EASLEY/1839-1924 — OSSW Nancy C. Easley.
- 4A.. NANCY C./EASLEY/1843-1924 — OSSW John P. Easley. The name Easley appears on the stone once, centered between the two inscriptions.

FM initialed B.P.C. OSSW Infant daughter of W. C. & Bettie P. Cook and Edwin Merit Cook.
- 7A.. INFANT/Daut. of/W. C. & BETTIE P. COOK/Born & Died/Aug. 5, 1882. — OSSW Bettie P. Cook and Edwin Merit Cook.
- 7B.. EDWIN MERIT/Son of/W. C. & Bettie P. Cook/Born/May 26, 1881./Died/Oct. 31, 1881. — OSSW Bettie P. Cook and infant daughter of W. C. & Bettie P. Cook.
- 8... WILLIAM H. EASLEY/BORN/JAN. 10, 1841/Fell at the battle of PERRYVILLE/OCT. 8, 1862/A volunteer in the defense of the/Constitution of his fathers. — Above the name there is a sculpture of a U.S. flag flying in the breeze and leaning against the flag staff there is a rifle. FM initialed W.H.E.
- 9... EMILY F. EASLEY/BORN/DEC. 25, 1844/DIED/MAR. 20, 1858 — Below the name there is a sculpture of a rose. FM initialed E.F.E.
- 10.. NELLIE G./DAU. OF/S. A. & CLEO/BROWN/1917 - 1920
- 11.. ELIZABETH McW./EASLEY/1818 - 1894
- 12... SARAH E./Daut. of/J. E. & E. E./EASLEY/Born/Mar. 28, 1861/Died/Oct. 27, 1889/Gone, but not forgotten. — This is an obelisk type marker standing about 5' high. OSSW Joseph Easley, Jr.

- 13... M. W. HIEATT/BORN/Oct. 19, 1831;/DIED/July 29, 1846. — OSSW J. B. Hieatt. SD. Above the name there is a sculpture of two lambs resting.
- 13A. J. B. HIEATT/BORN/Jan. 31, 1834;/DIED/Aug. 29, 1846. — OSSW M. W. Hieatt.
- 14... Wm. H. HIEATT/BORN/Apr. 4, 1827;/DIED/Feb. 5, 1846. — SBT the last letter in the name and also through the word 'Born'. Above the name there is a sculpture of a resting lamb.
- 15... COL. MERIDETH HIEATT/BORN/MARCH 31, 1785;/DIED/April 23, 1868.
- 16... OUR MOTHER/JUDITH/Wife of/M. HIEATT/BORN/Apr. 24, 1795./DIED/May 21, 1874. — SD. SBT below the inscription.
