Isaiah 26:8 – “Yes, Lord, walking in your ways, we wait for you; for your name and your renown are the desires of our hearts.”

Think of the most famous person you can think of. What factors went into making this person so famous?

What part have you played in spreading this person's fame?

❖ **Read verse 12 of this chapter.**

How do the facts about **Israel** in this verse bring Glory to God and not to man?

❖ **Read I Corinthians 3:6-7**

How do the facts about **our salvation and Christian Growth** bring glory to God not man?

❖ **Read I Peter 4:11**

How does the way in which we should **serve** God bring Glory to Him and not to man?

❖ **Read I Corinthians 15:9-10**

Paul often talks about boasting in the Lord not man. (I Cor. 1:29, 1:31, 3:21, 9:16, II Cor. 10:17, Gal. 6:14, Eph. 2:9) How do we see in this verse why he would be so passionate about this?

How do the facts about **Paul's Christian growth** bring glory to God?

- ❖ One important question to ask is *WHY* should God's name and renown be the desires of our souls?

Look back to the verses above; you probably noticed a unifying theme in each of these verses. What is this theme, and how should it motivate you to make God's name and renown the desires of your soul?

- ❖ Think back to that famous person in the beginning of our study. Compare the things that make this person famous, to the things that make God famous. How do his feats measure up to God's?
- ❖ In light of who God is, what He has done for you, and what He promises to do in the future, how can you individually, as a family member, and as a Jericho Valley Church family member, passionately make God famous to those you come in contact with?
