Rochester High Noon Club meets the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of each month from NOON to 1 pm.

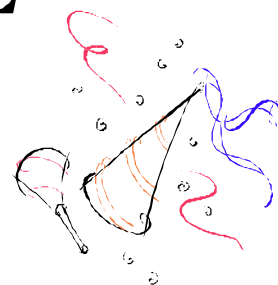
Meetings are located in the Alliance Building on Stone Street, 3rd floor board room.

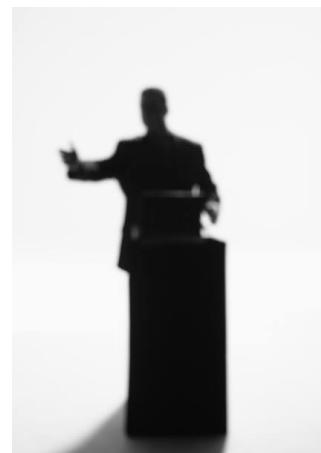
