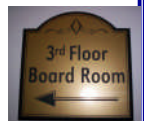
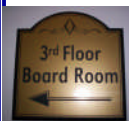

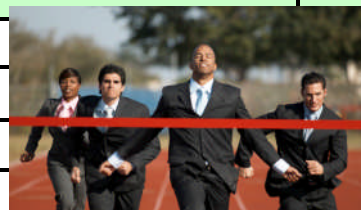
To be President's Distinguished, our club must meet 9 of the 10 goals established by Toastmasters International.
