Did you know that in order to deal with the increased number of students currently attending Livingston High School...

- The Media Reference Room was converted to a classroom with 30 computer stations. Computers were placed in desks, underneath and out of the way, creating the flexibility required for multiple curriculum needs such as math and social studies.
- The Media Periodicals Room was converted to accommodate Small Group Instruction.

A little history...

The changes to these two rooms were made to help maintain course offerings while keeping a check on the number of students per class. Moving the materials from these rooms, of course, decreases the available space in the Media Center. This limited space, in turn, limits the activities that the Media Center is able to accommodate. In addition, the previous scope of reference materials is not as easily accessible. ***More needs to be done.***
