### *Did you know. . .*

- There has been a 32% increase in student population at LHS between 1990-1991 and 2004-2005.
- By the 2008-2009 school year, this number is estimated to be 44% over 1990-1991.
- By 2013-2014, it is estimated to be 67% over 1990-1991.

### *A little history. . .*

The Long Range Planning Committee, composed of school district personnel, parents and community members, was formed in 1996. Its efforts resulted in significant construction in the elementary and middle schools in order to meet the academic needs of our growing enrollment. Upon the Committee's recommendation, the FUSE (Facility Use Student Enrollment) Committee was formed to identify space and room needs at Livingston High School and address them over the foreseeable future.
