New! The Maureen L. & Howard N. Blitman, P.E. Scholarship to Promote Diversity in Engineering (\$5,000). This new NSPE scholarship will be awarded to a high school senior (male or female), from an ethnic minority, who has been accepted into an ABET-accredited engineering program at a four-year college or university. The award, \$5000 for the freshman year, has been endowed by Mr. and Mrs. Blitman, to encourage students from ethnic minorities that are underrepresented in the field of engineering, to pursue this challenging and rewarding career. Auxiliary Scholarship (\$4,000) (Female, \$1,000 a year for four years) The recipient of this scholarship may attend the college or university of her choice (the program must be accredited by the Engineering Accreditation Commission of the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology). The scholarship is awarded strictly on the basis of achievement. A scholarship renewal report will be required for subsequent payment.

Virginia D. Henry Memorial Scholarship (\$1,000) (Female, \$1,000 for freshman year). The recipient of this scholarship may attend the college or university of her choice (the program must be accredited by the Engineering Accreditation Commission of the Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology).
