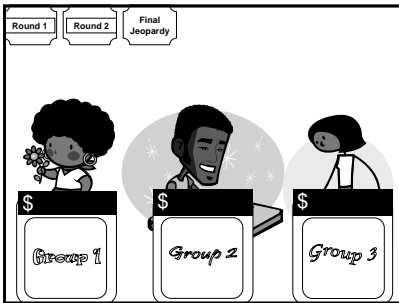

- Directions:
- Scroll through the presentation and enter the answers (which are really the questions) and the questions (which are really the answers).
