

# Pre-Freshmen in Computer Science Program for Recent High School Graduates

When: June 5 - July 28, 2005

Where: The Tuskegee University Computer Science Department

Sponsor: PREFICS Program (sponsored by Microsoft, HP, Xerox and Raytheon) is an eight-week summer program for 2005 high school graduates. Selected students will have the opportunity to earn up to 8 credit hours in college level mathematics, computer science, and freshman orientation courses.

Cost: Tuition and Room and Board will be provided free of charge. A non-refundable application fee (\$35), books, supplies, travel, program fee (\$300) and personal expenses are the responsibility of the student.

Affiliated Scholarship: Scholastically qualified students who choose to continue their study in Computer Science at Tuskegee University and maintain a B average in the summer program will be eligible for scholarships sponsored by the National Science Foundation and other private organizations.

Eligibility: To be eligible to participate in PREFICS your application for admission to Tuskegee University must be accepted, and must have completed at least three years of Mathematics at high school level.

Application: Forward a recommendation letter from a mathematics /computer science instructor or a school administrator, send an official high school transcript and include a short statement (50 words) about why you want to major in Computer Science at Tuskegee University, completed application, non-refundable application fee, and other required materials by **April 30, 2005** to:
