## Project Procedures:

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. You must first research your topic. You must fill in the resource sheet included in this package.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. Next, you must write a GI paragraph about your topic...to be included on your introduction slide;
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. You must write an opinion and conclusion paragraph to be included in your presentation near the end. This will tell us what you think and what you conclude from the evidence gathered;
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. You must make a list of important facts about your topic;
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. Now, find pictures about your topic and to use in your slide show and save them to the server under your name. Follow the instructions on the power point handout included in this package.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. Now, complete the storyboard. See this sheet for instructions.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. Finally, complete the power point presentation. Once completed, practice the presentation.

## Storyboard Directions:

- The storyboard is a rough sketch of your power point presentation.
- Each box represents a slide;
- You must write the names of the pictures, and a brief description of the information you plan to use on each slide...this includes colors, animation, and so on.
- REMEMBER...the only slides that should contain a lot of writing are the GI slide and opinion slide; the remaining slides should have key words or phrases only. DO NOT write everything you plan to say on the slides!

## Power Point Requirements:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Introduction slide...that includes your topic (use word art here), member's names, and animation;
- \_\_\_\_\_ One slide that includes a picture directly related to your topic and basic information about it;
- \_\_\_\_\_ An ending slide that will include your opinion paragraph or concluding paragraph.
- \_\_\_\_\_ One slide will need to have the GI paragraph about your topic;
- \_\_\_\_\_ At least 3 slides with basic phrases or key words that you will tell us about, in detail, during your oral presentation;
- \_\_\_\_\_ At least one slide may have sounds, but it cannot be letter by letter or word by word...in other words, sound is not to be used on the GI or Opinion slides!
- \_\_\_\_\_ Do not use background music or clip art found on the computers in the lab. You must transfer it to your server or the blank disk that I will provide;
- \_\_\_\_\_ At least on slide, besides the introduction slide, must have animation; NOTE: If you work on this at home, a floppy disk will only hold 2 slide with sound and animations; So, only do the slides there and save the rest for the lab days...if you work at home
