Our building served as the Primary School for the Brady Square and Washington Station communities since 1892

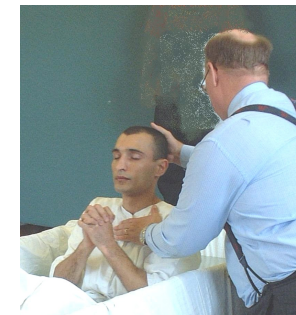
After renting buildings as required, we were blessed to gain the premises in 1995, rent free for the next ten years.

We have hosted community evangelism events, particularly during August, including in 1999 a fayre representing life in Jerusalem at the time of Jesus, including a huge representation of the Temple and markets
